



Integration course for women - register now!

Dear women and mothers,

Learning German is important for everyone. Being proficient in German will enable you to communicate better, e.g. with authorities, with doctors, at schools or in kindergartens. An ability to speak German is particularly important for women, as it allows them to handle many things on their own.

There is a German course available specifically for women. It is called the 'Women's integration course', and is a special integration course offering a number of great advantages:

- It is for women only
- It provides more time than the general integration course, giving you more time to spend on your family and on studying
- It covers particular topics, such as kindergarten, school and the German education system, so you are able to properly assist your children.
- It provides information on support options in Germany and on employment and careers

To attend the women's integration course, you will either need a *Berechtigungsschein* permit for participating in an integration course (available from foreigners' bureaus, job centres or social welfare offices) <u>or</u> you can *apply for admission* to an integration course through the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF), Chemnitz Branch, Otto-Schmerbach-Str. 20, 09117 Chemnitz. This will depend on your residency status.
