Foremost human

The motto of this year's Intercultural Days is simply "Foremost human". It is intended to encourage reflection on what it means to be human in general and especially in times of crisis and war. This includes questions such as: What connects and distinguishes us? What is the foundation of our humanity and thus of our coexistence? How do we perceive similarities and differences? How and why do conflicts arise? And what strategies are useful for resolving conflicts?

The key aspects of the Intercultural Days also invite us to enter into dialogue together. This year they are:

- Telling migration stories
- Human and fundamental rights at risk
- Economy needs diversity
- Promoting similarities in sport
- Living interreligious exchange

The state capital of Dresden will join the "Diversity Charter" during the Intercultural Days, thereby committing itself as an employer to an appreciative working environment, free of prejudice and independent of age, origin and nationality, gender and gender identity, physical and mental abilities, religion and ideology, sexual orientation and social background. This charter is an initiative launched in 2006 to promote diversity and equal opportunities in companies and institutions. The aim of the initiative is to promote the recognition, appreciation and inclusion of diversity in the world of work in Germany. To date, over 5,000 organisations have signed the "Diversity Charter" — I am delighted that Dresden is now one of them

I am also delighted that we have once again succeeded in putting together a varied, colourful and exciting intercultural programme this year and would like to thank all those involved for their commitment in preparing and organising this annual series of events.
